

OUAB Camp Attendee Processes:

Prior to Coming:

- No student who has had a known exposure to a person with COVID19 can participate until 14 days after the known exposure.
- No student who has tested positive for the COVID19 virus can participate until 14 days after a second negative test.
- OUAB will require each participant's parent (or legal guardian) to sign the **Wellness Authorization Form** attesting to the health of the participant and the members of the participant's household. OUAB will require completing and signing of this form before the student can participate. This form is to be filled out on site only. This form will contain requirements that include the following:
 - No students with recent or current COVID19 virus symptoms may attend.
 - Parents must consent to immediate pick-up of a student that suddenly shows symptoms.
 - Child will be isolated, and parents are notified to pick up their child immediately.
- A **Liability Waiver** provided by OUAB/MTC that is specific to COVID19 will also need to be signed.

OUAB staff will also do their due diligence to ensure their own health and will take precautions outlined by the CDC and SC government officials, including daily health screenings.

- Temperature of teachers and students will be taken and recorded to ensure the safety of all attending camps and classes.
- Should an instructor feel ill, they will have a replacement for the class.
- Notification of all student's parents of possible illness.

Students must come fully dressed for class (dance shoes included) as they will not be able to change into their dance clothes once they have come to class. No other personal items are permitted in the building.

OUAB Drop off and Pick up Process:

MASKS:

- Staff will not be required to wear masks while teaching as they would not be appropriate for the activity of these camps, however, they will keep a distance between themselves and the students. Staff will only be required to wear masks when doing close-contact necessities.
- The staff members checking temperatures and serving snacks will wear masks and gloves during that time.
- Parents are welcome to send their child in a mask at their own discretion. Teachers can not be found at fault if a child refuses to wear their mask.

DROP OFF:

- In accordance with AccelerateSC's Guidelines for Day Camps, parents will not be allowed to enter the building so that we can limit the amount of people in our sanitized space.
- An OUAB front office staff member will meet the students and parents outside of the building for check in and health screening.
 - Only lunch/snacks and water bottle are allowed with students. No additional clothing or other materials with the students, please.
 - An assistant will escort the students to their lead teacher as they come in after checking in outside.

PICK UP:

- All parents will line up for curbside pickup in the back of our building.
- No parent can enter the building. If you need to pick up your child early for any reason, please call the front office (843-388-3272) and a staff member will bring your child out.
- Parents are to wait at their car until their child is delivered to them after class.
 - Students will be brought out to their parent by the instructor/assistant.

OUAB Classroom and Building Use Requirements:

- There can be NO physical contact. (No hugs, high fives, or partner dancing) will happen in the classroom.
- Hands will be washed thoroughly before and after snack time and throughout the camp, as necessary.
- All students will receive hand sanitizer when they enter the classroom.
- For weekly camps, spaces will be marked out in the room while dancing to ensure the appropriate space between dancers.
- Water fountains will only be available to refill students' water bottles. Each student must bring their own labeled water bottle.
- NO other personal items are permitted, outside of personal snack or lunch for day camps.
- Instructors are required to wear gloves when handling and assisting with food items, or assisting campers in the restroom.
- All props, surfaces, etc. will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use and will not be shared between students.
- Students must come fully dressed for class as they will not be able to change into their dance clothes once they have arrived at the studio. This includes dance shoes.

OUAB Class sizes:

Adjustments will continue to be made based on the recommended CDC and DHEC regulations as stated by the Governor's order.

State of SC Guidelines for Performing Arts Camps that we will be adhering to:

- Campers and instructors should follow recommended physical distancing and good hand hygiene practices prior to/following performing arts activities.
- Consider planning performing arts activities to include the same group of campers and instructors per group.
- All shared and used equipment (e.g., props) should be cleaned and disinfected between each use and the performing arts area should be cleaned and disinfected after use.
- Consider designating certain equipment to individuals for the duration of camp to decrease the amount of shared items.
